The concept of the **Little Free Library** is that it belongs to everyone: neighbors, friends, or people who pass by. Anyone may use it. If you see something you would like to read, take it. Browse through and see who read it or gave it. When finished, you can leave your own special note in it.

You can pass them on to a friend or return them to any **Little Free Library**. We are registered nationally and have a charter number. Locations for all Little Free Libraries can be found on the Little Free Library's website (littlefreelibrary.org), where you can search for them by zip code.

Neighbors are invited to *"Take a book, return a book."*
(Children's books, cookbooks, fiction, non-fiction, etc.)
